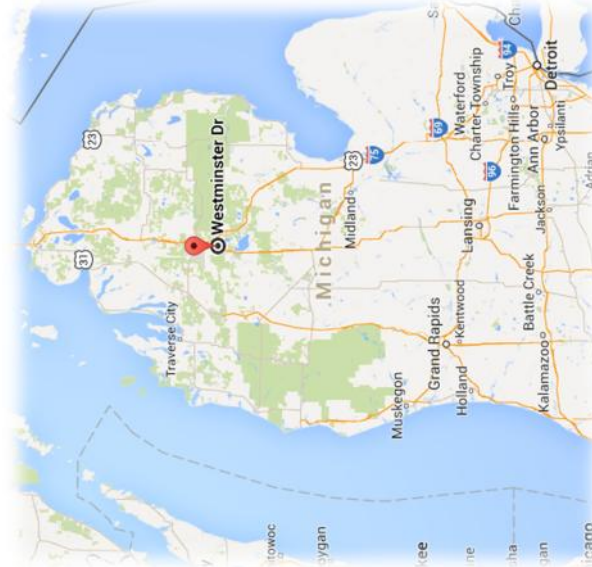

Groups commonly help with maintenance initiatives such as painting, staining, groundskeeping and trail maintenance. We have also partnered with Kids Against Hunger and Presbyterian Disaster Assistance to provide support for individuals and families affected by hunger or disaster. During a Kids Against Hunger packaging event, your group will package 10,000 meals for hungry families in the U.S. and abroad.
