## Capstone Piece to the Leadership Track:

## Westminster to the World Begins



The final part of the leadership track at Camp Westminister will be instituted this summer: a pilgrimage to another culture, mission site and Christian community. Seven high school graduates and three chaperones will travel to the Iona Community in Scotland for a week in mid-June.

"We began dreaming of an opportunity like this 4 years ago," said Assistant Director, Elise Bates Russell. "The intention is to give these campers a view of another authentic community, as well as a chance to reflect on their individual faith journeys."

During the stay at Iona, the group will participate in worship, personal reflection, leadership training, a ceilidh (Scottish party and dancing), a local one-day pilgrimage around the island, and work- each group staying at the Abbey is required to help with cleaning, gardening, food prep and whatever is needed to keep the place going. In other words, capers!

Iona is a spiritual community of people that extends the world over. The actual abbey was rescued and restored in the 1930s by a Presbyterian pastor, George MacLeod. He described Iona as a "thin place" - only a tissue paper separating the material from the spiritual. We like to think that Camp Westminister is a thin place too!

To spend some time in such a historic and inspiring setting is to be open to challenge and the exploration of new horizons. Our group will be on site with three other youth groups from Denmark, Norway and the USA.

At the end of the week at Iona, the group will return to Higgins Lake for another week. In addition to debriefing, the campers will be working through a new curriculum by the Office of Vocation PC(USA)- Listening for God's Call. We see career and calling discernment as a vital part of the leadership track.

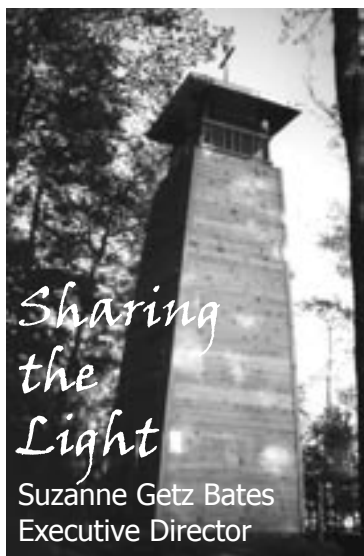
## 12 Years of Partnership for the Music and Drama Camps

## The Duck Survives!

It was a calm, sunny, July morning on Higgins Lake. Campers finished breakfast, capers and hearing a Bible story in Frehse Hall about caring for one another. They broke up into smaller groups and were getting ready to discuss life applications. One group had just settled in the rocking chairs on the dining hall porch

when they were amazed to see an eagle swoop down into Higgins Lake and pick up a duck. Soon everyone heard an incessant squawking from the lake. The duck's mate never gave up the clamor until the eagle let go of the mate.

The injured duck took refuge under the lift for one of camp's watercraft and we watched the eagle struggle to take off again. Remembering the Bible study, some campers begged us to get help for the duck. An animal shelter was located some miles away but who was going to get the duck in a box wrapped in a towel (as they suggested) after watching the mate go after the eagle? Eventually, the pair quietly left for a more secluded spot. No one will ever forget that sight!

Lives are changed at Camp Westminster on Higgins Lake. Not only do campers watch eagles and draw some pretty exciting conclusions for their own lives, they interact with some of the most skilled youth development specialists around! The experience on Higgins Lake helps children, young people and families experience God's love in a fun, beautiful, outdoor, Christian community. The camp is very grateful to all who contribute their time, gifts and skills toward making the camp a success. Campership donations enable many campers to attend who otherwise could not afford camp. ## Legacy Campers | The Miller- Erickson Clan

My dad, Bill Miller, was a camper in the early 1930s. He was the waterfront director in the summer of 1942. My dad was raised in Westminster Church of Detroit. He remembers canoeing around the lake for overnight campouts when there was no other development along the lake.

Then “us kids” started going: my brothers Skip Miller, Andy Miller and sisters Martha Miller, Mary Ann Miller and Amy Miller went for many years each in the late 1960s to mid 70s. My cousin Julianne Lyons attended for years too.

The third generation of our family started [attending camp] in the 1990s with Amy’s son Tommie Willis and Martha’s daughter Madeleine Boudreau. My sons Skipper and Britton started in 2007 followed by their cousins (Mary Ann’s kids) Wes

and Anna Erickson. Julianne’s son William Patterson attended and hopefully this year, more members of our family will join the tradition!

[Note from camp office: We have Ericksons signed up for expeditions and on-site camps this year!]

Third generation camper Britton says, “Camp Westminster ROCKS, ” and his older brother, Skipper, adds “I recommend it to all my friends.”

Somewhere I have a photo of me wearing a CW teeshirt on the back of a truck preparing to head out on a canoe trip. Back then we didn’t have cameras so we only have mental images of things we did. I just checked my old scrap book and I have all the letters my counselors wrote to my parents after camp and letters I received at camp.

I love sending my kids to Camp Westminster so they can share in a common experience of what their Grampa did and all of their aunts and uncles. My dad taught us some of the camp songs and when we get together we all sing them. The songs are especially meaningful. So many of them convey a deep love for God and weave His strength into your heart and soul amidst the wilderness setting and the fellowship that is Camp Westminster. We all learned to canoe, start fires, camp and worship in the outdoors. There is something about the smell of the pines, the cold water at the greenies, the daddy longlegs, the green and white wakeyas, the songs and campfires that become “graven on our hearts and minds as through life our journey winds”. It is true, “memories linger on”.

## 'Come to the Water' Update - Higgins Lake Camp Staff Certification School Planned

Camp Westminster will implement an important part of its strategic plan, *Come to the Water*, in Spring 2011 by opening a training school for camp staff and young adults. Beginning May 31 through June 7, the Higgins Lake Camp Staff Certification School will offer five different training courses.

Director Suzanne Getz Bates emphasizes, "This school was created to enable camp staff to receive all the necessary training courses and certifications that meet ACA standards at one time and in one location."

One-day courses are available in first aid, archery, and CPR for the professional rescuer. Multi-day courses include lifeguarding, sailing, team challenge

course facilitation, and high ropes facilitation. Class size is limited to 12 participants for each course.

All training will be held on-site at Camp Westminster on Higgins Lake, located in Roscommon, Michigan. Trainers have been certified by the applicable governing body, including the American Red Cross, U.S. Sailing Association and the Association for Challenge Course Technology. Trainees will include staff from Michigan camp facilities. Food and lodging are provided in the cost for training. Certificates will be issued to each participant who successfully completes the requirements for each training course.
